Catholic Schools Week

The 35th annual National Catholic Schools Week is January 31st through February 6th. It is a national celebration of the important role Catholic elementary and secondary schools across the nation play in providing values. There will be a Pancake Breakfast, sponsored by the Parent's Guild and the 6th, 7th, and 8th grades, following the 9:30 School Mass on January 31st. Immediately following the 12:00 Mass, the Parents' Guild will also be sponsoring a Spanish Food Sale in Assumption Hall. We will have activities for the students during the week. The Parents' Guild will then sponsor a Spaghetti Dinner and basket raffle on February 6th immediately following the 5:00 School Mass. Please contact the school to volunteer for these events. Remember, every family needs to have a minimum of 10 volunteer hours by May 31st.

Reminders

January, February, and March means cold, nasty weather. Please remember to make sure your children come to school dressed for the cold weather. They need a jacket that can be closed (no broken zippers), a hat, and gloves. If there are no puddles on the blacktop, we go outside for recess.

Students should not be wearing sweatshirts or jackets other than the St Mary's sweatshirt or fleece in school.

I'm sure that we will be getting snow throughout the remainder of the winter. Please remember to check the local stations for information regarding school cancellations. St. Mary's follows New London Public Schools regarding cancellation of classes.

Tuition is due the first of the month. For those families paying monthly, 60% of your tuition should be paid by January 8th. It is essential that your tuition be paid on time because St. Mary's primary source of funds is tuition from our families.

All families are required to volunteer at the school or at Parents' Guild sponsored events. Parents must volunteer a minimum of 10 hours by the end of May. In addition, families are required to raise a minimum of \$100 in fundraisers. If these requirements are not met, families will be assessed an additional \$100 to be paid before the last week of school.
